In the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of this year, it was our dream to have a customized E-bike to be used for our then plan to have a Teaching at Home Project wherein, the team will be the one to go down the community to reach those blind children who cannot go to the Home because of restrictions. In the second part of this year the visionistas as well as parents and some friends contributed for the 7<sup>th</sup> Year anniversary Tricycle Project of Future Vision Home in March. We gathered a total amount of 22,200 PHP

Now that we have the Customized Tricycle which we named “Baraks and Beauty”, this money will be used to buy additional accessories and materials for the tricycle. Thanks to “kanthari Foundation Switzerland”.

## Our Dreams for Future Vision:



Just like the plants in our Hardinña Mansion, Future Vision Home is growing. Visionistas/students increase in numbers, meaning our Future Vision family is getting bigger. Activities also increase but our space is getting smaller for all of us. It is our dream to have a House and Lot with a front yard and backyard at the same time with parking space for the service vehicles of Future Vision Home. A space that can accommodate all the visionistas/students including some of its volunteers and that can also have enough space to facilitate all our indoor and outdoor activities. We also want a space that there is a safe parking area for the service vehicles of the Home.

Our Plans for the next five years is to be able to branch out to other areas particularly in Quezon Province where the founder spent most of her childhood. The Founder would like to reach out those children/youth blind in her birth place.

Aside from a bigger space for us, we are in need of financial support to sustain what we do:

### 1. Daily Expenses

Right now we are thankful that we have funding from "kanthari Switzerland Foundation" and this funding covers about 70% of our monthly expenses. This funding will go until November of year 2022. The rest of the funding requirements are drawn from personal salary of the founder and from contributions from beneficiaries/students/visionistas' parents/guardians and some from occasional love gifts from friends and anonymous individuals.
